What a busy September! The children really enjoyed our first month of school exploring our classrooms and meeting new friends. We also spent time working on individual assessments and will continue developing specific learning objectives for each student. We are trying something new this year, I will be writing an overview that will be sent along with your child's progress report. These fall reports are really a base line and our ability to make observations of growth is more obvious during our kindergarten readiness and spring conferences.

Our MWF preschool class began the year learning about creation, Noah and the tower of Babel during Bible time, and we will continue to journey through the Old Testament learning about Abraham, Isaac, Jacob/Esau, and Joseph. Our goal is that the children begin to see how the Bible "fits" together and to sequence people and events. Our T-TH class learned about love - care and concern for others, with the help of Strawberry Sam, along with Bible stories about love and friendship. During October we will be learning about the Fruit of the Spirit - Joy.
